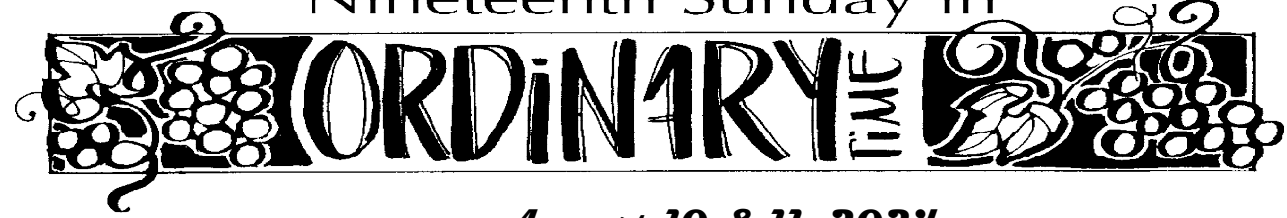
SEEKING NOMINATIONS FOR THE LONGEST MARRIED COUPLE PROJECT!
