"I would like to encourage you to include the annual Diocesan Appeal in your end-of-year giving plans if you haven't given already. Our Lady of Lourdes Parish/Ravenna parish goals are \$17,689 with 70 households contributing. Two months into this appeal and our parish has already reached 50% of our dollar goal. We need \$8,764.00 and 41 more households to donate to reach both our goals. If we reach both our dollar goal and donor goal by December 31st, our parish will qualify for a drawing for a \$5,000 rebate. St Mary's Parish/Pleasanton parish goals are \$3,192 with 12 households contributing. We need \$1,792 and 6 more households to donate to reach both our goals.

National Eucharistic Revival--The Eucharistic Prayer

The Eucharistic Prayer is the heart of the Liturgy of the Eucharist. In this prayer, the celebrant acts in the person of Christ as head of his body, the Church. He gathers not only the bread and the wine, but the substance of our lives and joins them to Christ's perfect sacrifice, offering them to the Father. The introductory dialogue establishes that this prayer is the prayer of the baptized and ordained, is offered in the presence of God, and has thanksgiving as its central focus. Following this dialogue, the celebrant begins the Preface, which consists of four different Eucharistic Prayers. After these prayers, communion is then given.

CCW Clothing Drive


