Higher Ground

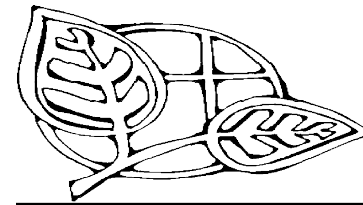
