Ash Wednesday Mass Times

On February 18th, Mass will be at 6:00 p.m. at BOTH OLL and St. Josaphat's. Those ages 18-59, in reasonable health, are required to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. Those 14 and older must abstain from meat on Fridays during Lent. Canon Law does mention that for young children not fasting, parents should still communicate the meaning and penance. And Stations of the Cross will again be held after the 8:00 a.m. Mass on Sundays starting on the 22nd. If those that helped with this last year do not want to do the stations, please let me know, otherwise I will assume you will lead them again and I will be sending out a schedule shortly.

***The collection on Ash Wednesday is for the Church in Central and Eastern Europe. This collection supports the Church in more than 25 countries that are still struggling to recover from former communist rule. It also aids communities throughout the region that are affected by the war in Ukraine. Funds support pastoral care, catechesis, renovations of church properties, and seminary formation.
