#### **Theology on Tap**

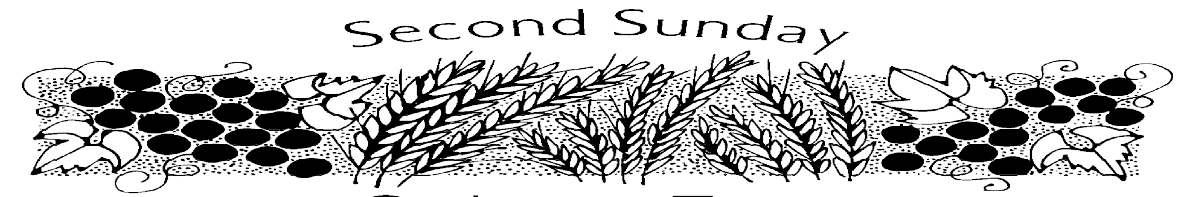
