National Eucharistic Revival “The Sacrifice of Christ”

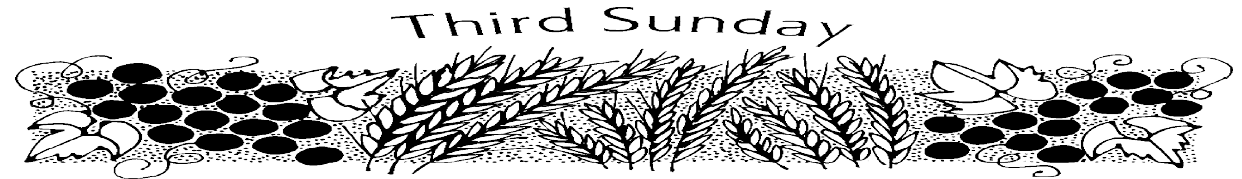
