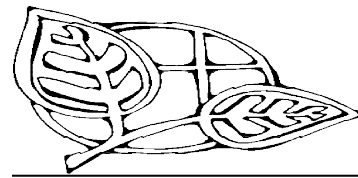
CASA (Court Appointed Special Advocates)
