Best Choice Bar Codes

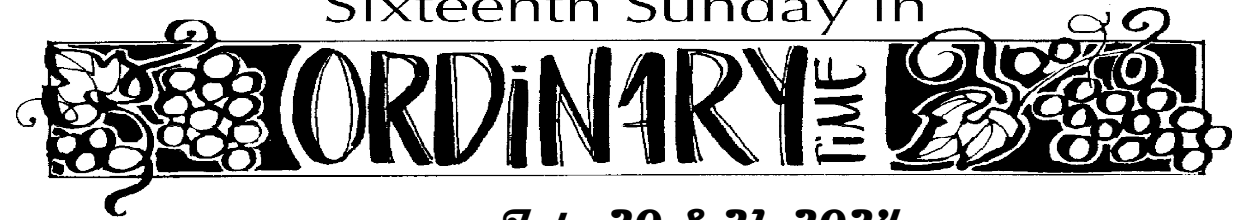
