Wear Red

Next weekend is Pentecost Sunday. Pentecost is a significant Christian festival celebrated 50 days after Easter, marking the gift of the Holy Spirit to the apostles. The term comes from the Greek word "pentekoste," meaning "fiftieth". We wear red on Pentecost Sunday to symbolize the fire of the Holy Spirit and the unity of believers. This tradition reflects the flames of the Spirit that descended upon the apostles, representing the transformative power of the Holy Spirit in the church. Additionally, wearing red signifies the good news of Jesus being communicated to all people, emphasizing inclusivity and the shared experience of faith. Overall, red serves as a visual reminder of the Holy Spirit's presence and the celebration of the church's mission. So wear your red.
