The Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ (Corpus Christi)

The Feast of Corpus Christi is a special celebration in the Catholic Church, established in the 13th century by Pope Urban IV following the visions of St. Juliana of Liège. It honors the real presence of Christ in the Eucharist, emphasizing that the bread and wine truly become His body and blood through transubstantiation. The feast is observed 60 days after Easter, typically on the Thursday after Trinity Sunday, though in some countries it is moved to the following Sunday for greater participation.
