For those who may not know, at the end of May I spent seven days in the hospital with five in the intensive care unit. It was a lung infection/pneumonia of some kind. The doctors think that I was not fully healed after the last bout of pneumonia in March. Included in this are some heart complications that, God willing, will resolve themselves. Thanks to your prayers, I'm still here. With this in mind, I do need to slow down a bit this summer to give the body a chance to heal. I'm planning on resuming saying Masses on the weekend but asking other priests to fill in until I feel better. All weddings, baptisms and funerals will be provided by me as health permits. Please feel free to contact me about any questions you may have as this is going to drive me stir crazy and I need to keep the brain occupied. Please let me know immediately of people in the hospital or on hospice so that I can visit them or arrange for another priest to do so. Wear Red

This weekend is Pentecost Sunday. Pentecost is a significant Christian festival celebrated 50 days after Easter, marking the gift of the Holy Spirit to the apostles. The term comes from the Greek word "pentekoste," meaning "fiftieth". We wear red on Pentecost Sunday to symbolize the fire of the Holy Spirit and the unity of believers. This tradition reflects the flames of the Spirit that descended upon the apostles, representing the transformative power of the Holy Spirit in the church. Additionally, wearing red signifies the good news of Jesus being communicated to all people, emphasizing inclusivity and the shared experience of faith. Overall, red serves as a visual reminder of the Holy Spirit's presence and the celebration of the church's mission. So wear your red.
