The Lamp in the Window

Every evening, Mrs. Callahan lit the small oil lamp in her front window. It wasn't much—just a soft, golden glow—but it had been her habit for decades. Neighbors often wondered why she kept it burning, even when electricity was plentiful. One rainy night, a young man knocked on her door. His clothes were soaked, his eyes red from tears. "I'm sorry to bother you," he said, "but I saw your light. I didn't know where else to go." Over tea, he explained that he had been walking aimlessly, feeling lost in more ways than one. The lamp had reminded him of his grandmother's home, a place where he had always felt safe. Mrs. Callahan smiled gently. "That's why I keep it lit. You never know who might be looking for a sign that they're not alone." The young man left with a lighter heart, and Mrs. Callahan's lamp continued to shine—quietly, faithfully—like a small echo of the greater Light that never goes out. Heart of Jesus, Aflame With Love For Us

As part of the celebration of the 250th anniversary of the signing of the Declaration of Independence, the U.S. Bishops consecrated the United States of America to the Sacred Heart of Jesus. Bishop Joseph Hanefeldt celebrated mass the morning of Saturday, June 13th, at St. Mary's Cathedral consecrating the Diocese of Grand Island to the Sacred Heart of Jesus.

In the Catholic Church, Ordinary Time is a liturgical season that occurs outside the major seasons of Advent, Christmas, Lent, and Easter. It is called "ordinary" not because it is dull or unimportant, but because the weeks are numbered in sequence (from the Latin ordinalis, meaning "numbered"). The term does not imply routine or mundanity, but rather a structured, sequential rhythm in the liturgical year
