Message From Father Richard

I have been asked many times over the past years about the feasibility of moving the main Altar to the center of the sanctuary (where, according to Church guidance it is supposed to be). Given how it was installed in the present configuration it will be labor intensive to change but I've found a company that specializes in such construction. We have obtained the permission of the Bishop for this endeavor and he wishes the Altar to be raised up a further step when moved to the middle. The cost of redoing the sanctuary will be about \$48,000. We do have the money on hand but I would like for people to donate to this worthy spiritual and worship cause. One couple has already donated \$10,000 for this purpose and all donations will be welcomed. If you have any questions or concerns, please do not hesitate to contact me.
