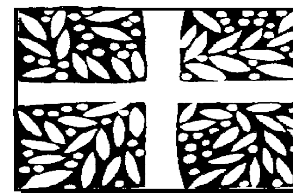

St. Peter and St. Paul are celebrated together because they were the two principal pillars of the early Christian Church. They were the founders of the See of Rome and played a significant role in the preaching, ministry, and martyrdom of the Church. St Peter was Jesus' first disciple, our first Pope and the Apostle to the Jews. He knew Jesus personally. St Paul however didn't physically meet Jesus, and as a Pharisee he initially hated and even persecuted the Christians, but after his miraculous conversion he became the Apostle to the Gentiles. He played a major role in reaching out to non-Jews, and 13 of the 27 letters in the New Testament have been attributed to him.
