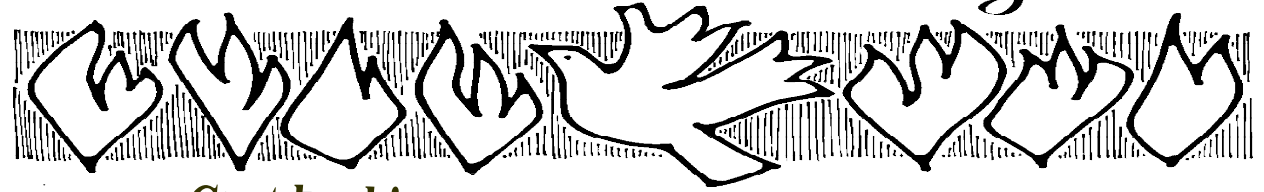
Fencing Fundraiser
