VOTE

Be sure to get out and vote this next Tuesday, November 5th. The 3 bishops of Nebraska urge Catholics to vote **FOR** Initiative 434 as a defense against the pro-abortion initiative. This will amend the Nebraska state constitution to protect babies in the 2nd and 3rd trimesters and keep women safe. And to vote **NO** on initiative 439 which would cement unregulated late-pregnancy abortion in the Nebraska Constitution, funded by taxpayers.
