
Fall Festival of Faith

Dedication and Significance

The dedication of the Lateran Basilica is celebrated on November 9 each year. Initially dedicated to Christ the Savior, the basilica was later rededicated to include Saints John the Baptist and John the Evangelist. This reflects its role as a central place of worship and governance for the Catholic Church, symbolizing unity among all churches. The Lateran Basilica is often referred to as the "mother church" because it serves as the cathedral of the Bishop of Rome (the Pope) and is considered the highest-ranking church in the world. It has been the site of numerous important events in the history of the Church, including synods and papal ceremonies. The Dedication of the Lateran Basilica is not only a celebration of a physical structure but also a commemoration of the enduring legacy of Christianity and the central role of the Catholic Church in the world. It stands as a testament to the faith and resilience of the Christian community throughout history.
