### Diocesan Appeal

The Annual Diocesan Appeal provides about 1/3 of the income that supports critical functions and ministries that serve and support the diocese's parishes and parishioners: **51%** of the Diocesan Budget lends itself to administrative support and general operations, i.e., Chancery Administration, Child Protection Office, Youth and Young Adult Office, Marriage Tribunal, Catholic Schools Administration, etc. **24%** of the Diocesan Budget offers support for Clergy and Seminarians, i.e., Vocations, Retired Priest Medical Ins., Continuing Education for Priests and retreats; **16%** of the Diocesan Budget goes toward Support for Youth & Young Adults- our Newman Centers, Higher Ground, Totus Tuus, Steubenville, Teens Encounter Christ, and March for Life. **10%** of the Diocesan Budget includes other ministries (Pro-Life, West Nebraska Catholic, CEC, and Community Mental Health).
