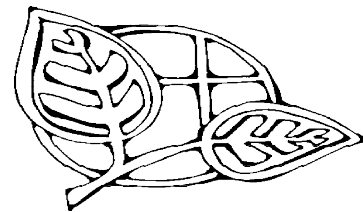
Shelton Sacred Heart Church
