FAQ About tge Diocesan Appeal

What is the overall goal for the Diocesan Appeal? How do you calculate the parish goal? The overall goal this year is \$1.2 million, the same as the last 3 years. We haven't met the overall goals in several years. Three years ago, we lowered the overall goal by \$130,000 and every parish goal decreased as well. Each parish goal is calculated by considering the parish offertory, a discount if the parish supports a school, and an adjustment based on the median income of the area where the parish is located. We decided to leave each parish goal the same this year as it was last year.
